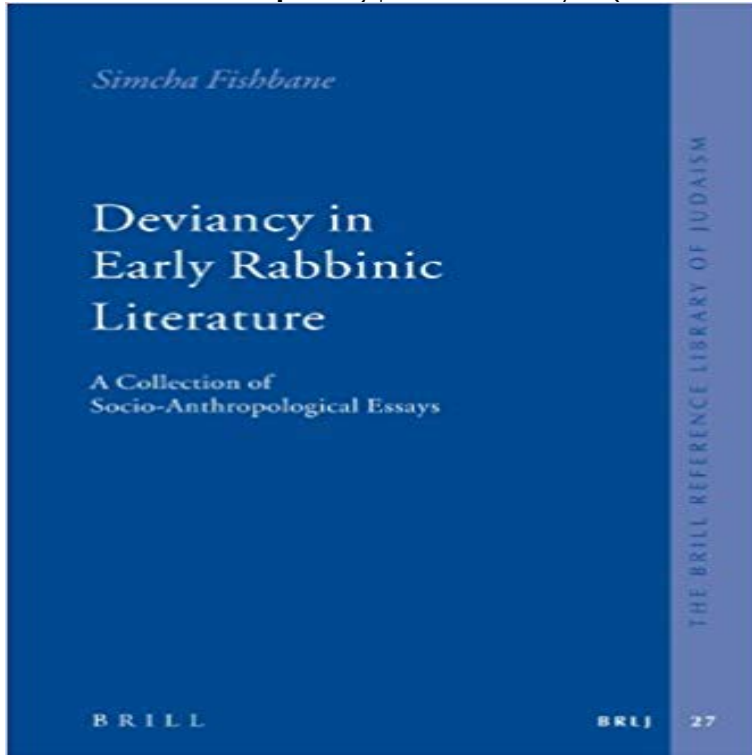


Deviancy in Early Rabbinic Literature: A Collection of Socio-Anthropological Essays (The Brill Reference Library of Judaism)

Social anthropological methodologies are used to provide a unique perspective on the implicit message of the redactors of these Rabbinic texts, and to make these important texts equally accessible to both scholars and laymen interested in acquiring a deeper understanding of these important issues.
