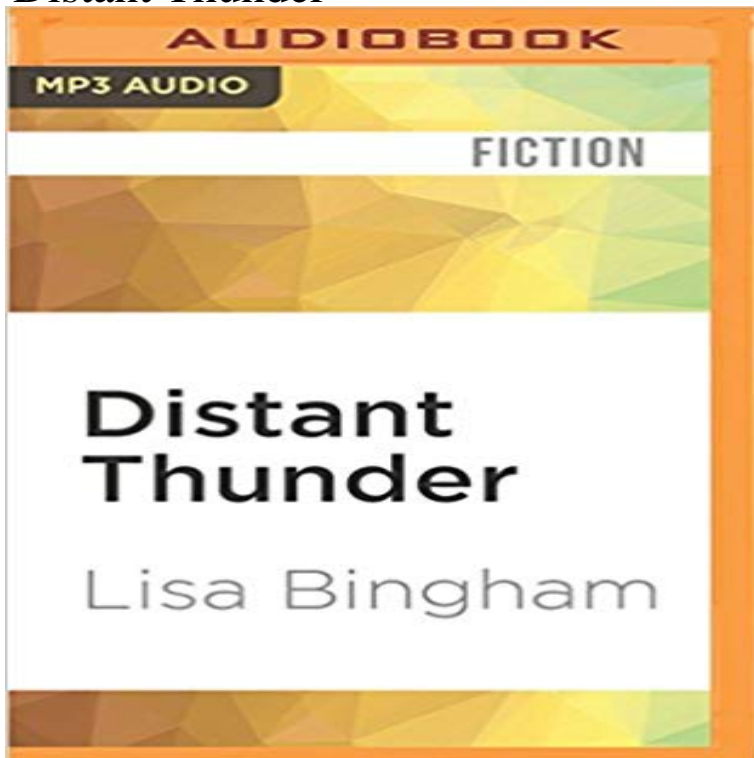


Distant Thunder
