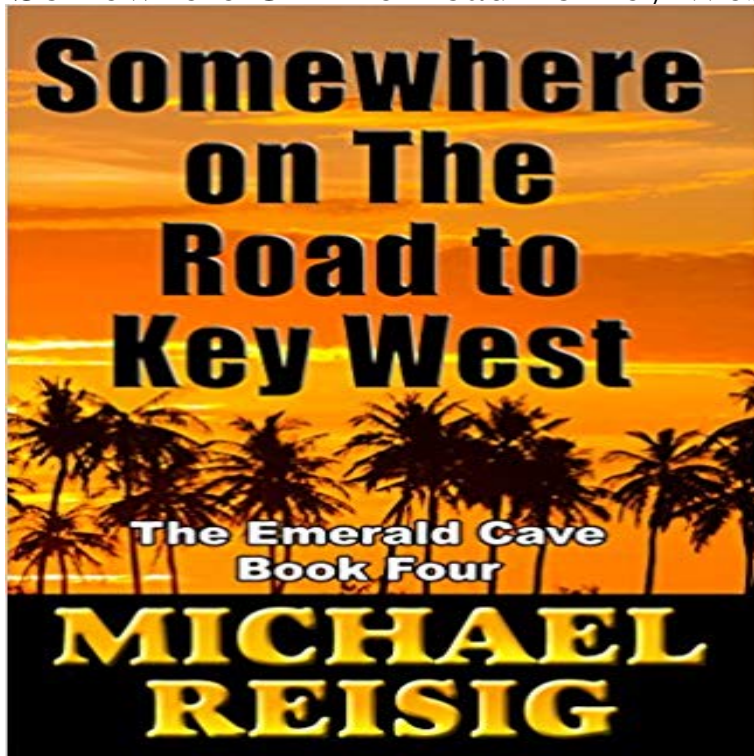


Somewhere On The Road To Key West
