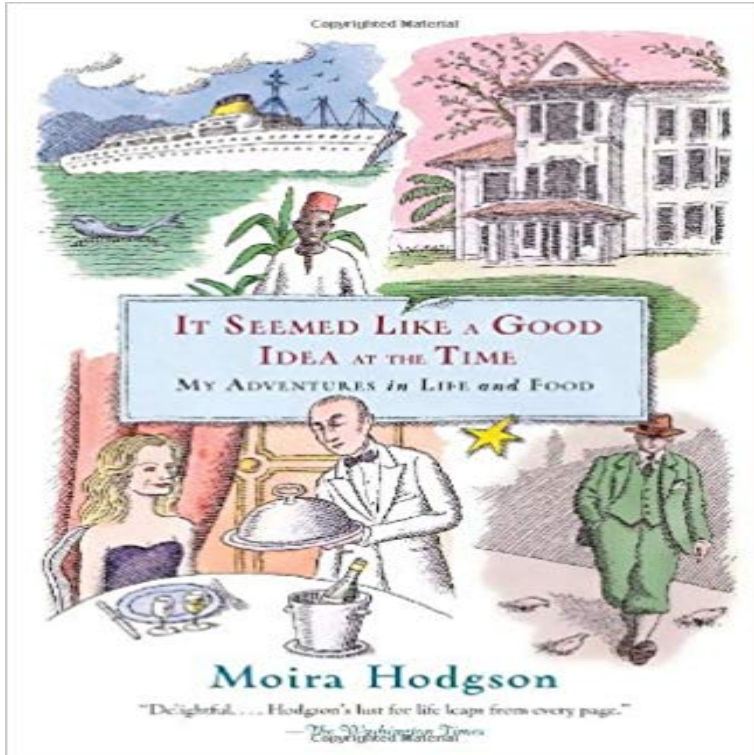


It Seemed Like a Good Idea at the Time: My Adventures in Life and Food
