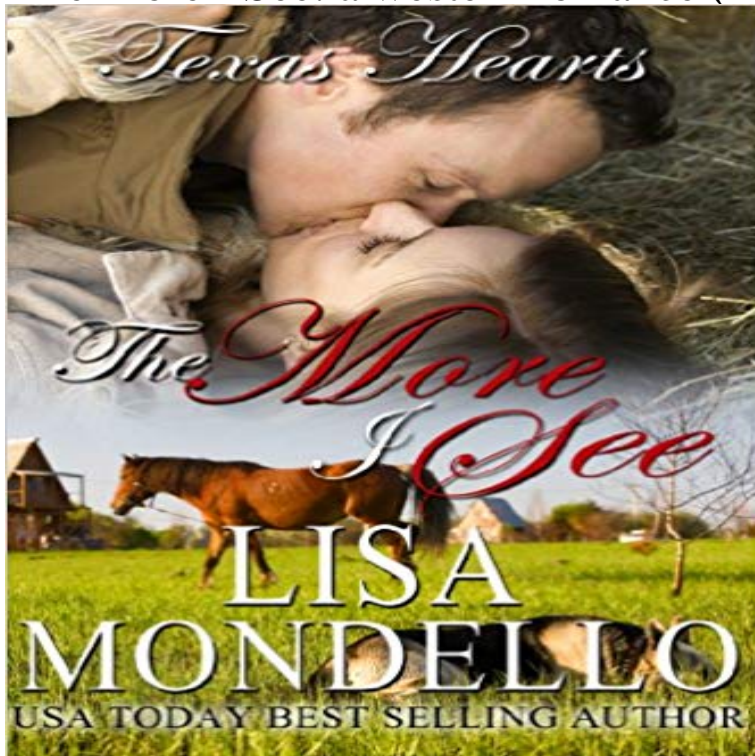


The More I See: a western romance (Texas Hearts Book 3)
